

LMGC Master Calendar 2012

Welcome to the Lakewood Men's Golf Club (LMGC) for the 2012 year! We have, as always, a great number of super events planned over the next 12 months, and we've prepared this "Master Calendar" to help you know in advance when – and what - they are. Here are a few explanatory notes:

1. Our Regular Monthly Tournaments (formats vary) are held once a month at Lakewood. They are for members in good standing (guest must be preapproved by the President, VP, Membership Chair or Tournament Chair), with the exception of the Member-Guest in September. The 2012 monthly tournaments are listed below.
2. We also hold a number of Special Events: Quad Club, Summer Shoot-outs, Away Tourneys, and more! These are mostly at sites away from Lakewood; some for LMGC members only, some for members and friends, and some in competition with golfers from other clubs. We've listed the ones here for which we have enough specifics at this time.
3. SCGA Events are run by our handicapping group, the Southern California Golf Association. Because of the recent merger of SCGA and our former handicapping group, PLGA (Publinks), we don't have too much information on the SCGA events yet – but we will publicize them as best as possible in the monthly newsletter and on our website as we get additional details and a better understanding of how SCGA works. 4. We hold a number of General Meetings on Wednesday evenings following the Regular Monthly tourneys, usually starting at 7:00 p.m. and lasting an hour to 90 minutes. They are a good opportunity to meet other members, find out more about upcoming events, and learn the results of the recent tournaments. We also occasionally conduct "special activities" at the General Meetings. In addition to the events listed, there's sure to be more added during the year.
